2. The Fair will furnish containers for seeds exhibit.
3. Sheaf grain and sheaf forage entries must be 3 inches in diameter, measured at the center band. (Maximum size - 5 inches in diameter)
4. **Grains and seeds must have been grown within the past year.**
5. An article **MUST** be meritorious to draw a premium and shall be entitled to first premium **ONLY IF MERITORIOUS**. First and second place ribbons may be awarded to one person, but the Fair **WILL NOT** pay second premium when a person is his only competition.
